This Date in History:

Date: Feb 5, 1995 Run: #539

Place: Long Beach Marathon Beer Check at Lindero & Ocean, 2 PM Hash start at Marine View Park on Eliot Street

The beer check started at 7:30 to 8 AM and we passed out beer, cheered on hashers as they tried to pass as racers, and some of us just passed out! RAT was early to the beer check. He was also supposed to scribe the 2 PM Hash and dreamed up seven rules of hashing:

1. Don't get drunk at the marathon beer check – RAT got lost trying to find the Hash start. TAKE A # finally escorted him.
2. Don't wait til 14 minutes after the hour to talk to the hare – Wanting to make this a hash to remember, RAT stumbled toward JOE ISUZU. Joe said "don't breathe on me" and ran away throwing flour
3. Don't believe a shortcutter- FUNGUS said he saw JOE ISUZU with flour and chalk at 7th and Bellflower. Expecting a prelay, RAT immediately got lost – trail never went in that direction.
4. Don't start a hash without FOTL – if FRUIT is not there, just blow off the hash.
5. Flour costs \$7. Chalkboard is free – a miniscule mark was found (while shortcutting). They spent 20 minutes searching and accidentally ran into flour and the pack.

7. Always get a scribe before the run: otherwise crap will be printed in the Snooze.
