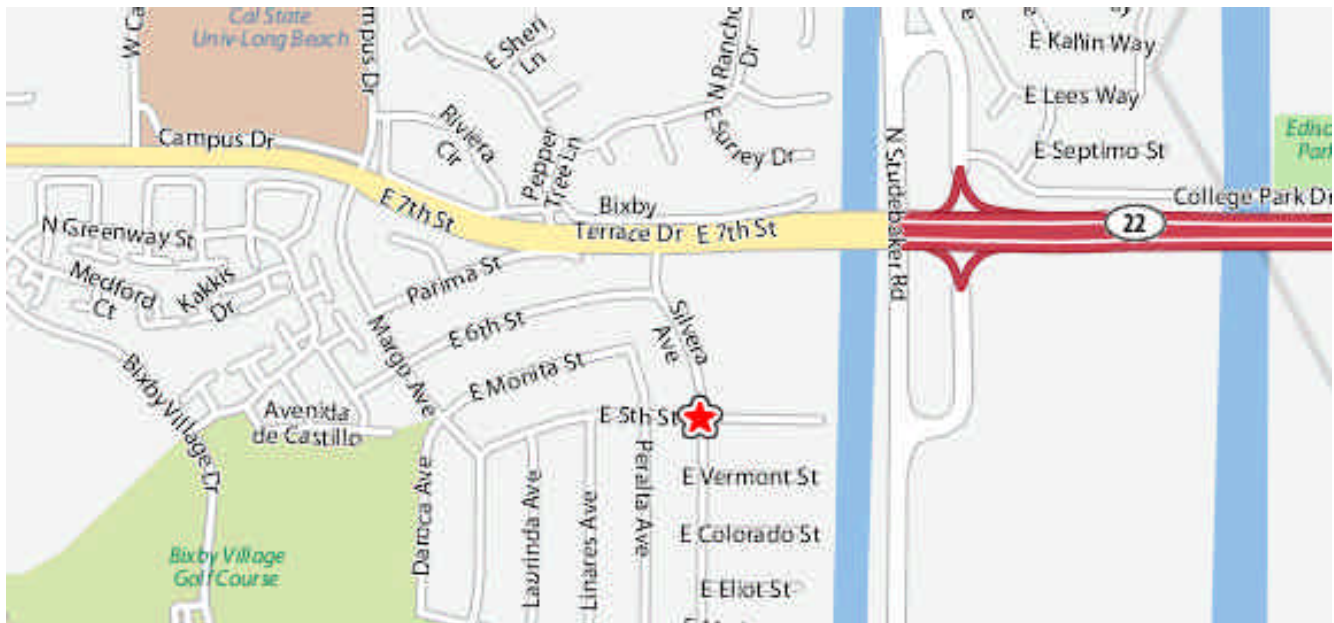
From the 405, heading South, exit Bellflower and turn left on 7th and continue as above; OR,
