Location: Lakewood  
Hares: PILLSBURY BLOW BOY & DA BUTT  
Miles: 5 Attendance: 82

Easter was much later in 2003, so when hashers assembled at Mae Boyer Park under cloudy skies, PILLSBURY informed the pack that the hares would be laying eggs (Easter eggs that is) along the trail and that prizes would be awarded to the lucky finders. DA BUTT was a last minute substitution for PILLSBURY's scheduled co-hare, and POOR AIM was a last minute substitution for absent timekeeper FRUIT OF THE LOOM. 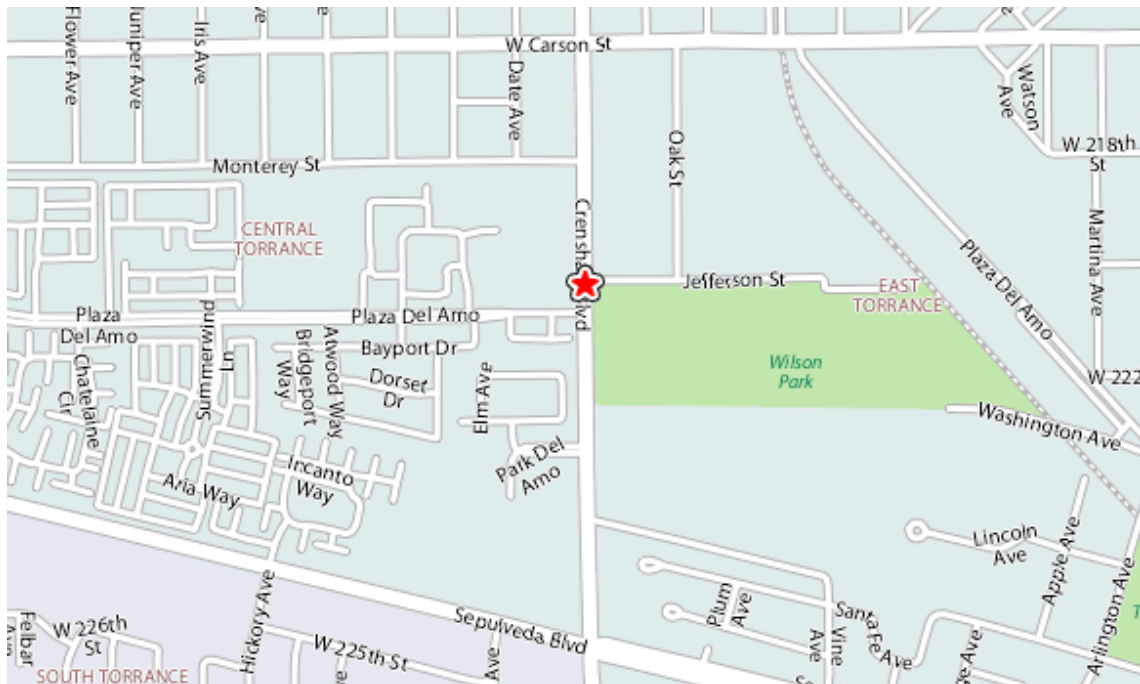
